## **Purpose:**

## **Divisions:**

2. Instead of an overall Homecoming winner, this year there will be a winner for each individual event. There will be four individual events helping to level out the playing field which will alleviate the competition aspect of Homecoming allowing more students to select which events to participate. This will enable students their level of participation and engagement in the events to further focus on FIU pride and supporting our student athletes to victory!

## General Rules and Regulations:

1. The 2011 Florida International University Homecoming theme is “If Roary Ran the Circus”. Teams must incorporate the overall theme at all events and competitions. Meetings to discuss rules will be held on July 20<sup>th</sup> at 5PM in GC 305. A second rules and regulations meeting will be held in the beginning of fall semester on August 26<sup>th</sup>, 2011 at 2pm.
2. The Overall Homecoming Council reserves the right to disqualify or deduct points from a competitor for ANY inappropriate behavior, choreography and/or design to any set designs, lip sync, banner, float, t-shirt competition, and events applicable to Homecoming. Inappropriateness includes, but is not limited to: the use of any illegal substance, alcohol, political propaganda, profanity, nudity, and poor sportsmanship.
3. ALL DECISIONS made by the Homecoming Executive Board are **final and will not be open for discussion**.
4. In case of an emergency, rules are subject to change at the discretion of the Executive Board.
5. Any complaint and/or violation can be submitted after filling out a complaint form, found attached to this packet. Complaint forms must be submitted no later than 24 hours after incident occurs. All forms must be accompanied by documentation of violation; i.e photographed or physical proof of violation. Forms must be emailed to **nvega006@fiu.edu**
6. If a team is participating in an event that requires a roster, the roster must be submitted by 5PM September 12, 2011 to GC 2214. The roster form is attached and requires the name of the participants and their panther ID’s.
7. A team’s eligibility is dependent on 4 active FIU students.
8. Participating groups are prohibited the use of an open flame during competition.
9. A team may choose whether to participate in one or more events. They are not limited to the number of events they may participate in.
10. All students must abide by University Policies and Procedures, FIU Student Code of Conduct, and by the Environmental Health & Safety contained in the student handbook.
11. The Team Registration Form, which can be found on page 17 of this packet, needs to be turned in by August 26<sup>th</sup>, 2011 at 5PM. The teams representative are responsible for conveying any and all information discussed at the Rules and Regulations meeting to their teams.
12. Any material that is to be submitted to the Homecoming council (including registration forms, sketches, rosters, banners, and t-shirts) **must** be handed in directly to any **current** Homecoming Council member. Materials are to be turned in **only** at the Homecoming office located in GC 2214 or at any of the Rules and Regulations meetings. All materials will be dated, time stamped, and filed by the council member.

## Team Name Guidelines:

*\*Team name must go with theme*

1. The Team name must go with the overall theme of Homecoming, “If Roary Ran the Circus...”
2. The team name must be evident in any of the individual competitions which a team participates in (Lip Sync/ Talent Show, T-shirt design, Banner design, and Float/ Spirit Car)
3. Team name is **not** allowed to include the participating organizations’ names and/or affiliations.
4. Each Team name will be different and selected on a first come first serve basis depending on submission order of rosters.
5. The Team name chosen **cannot** be changed after the Team Name form is turned in and accepted.
6. The Team Name Form can be found on page 18 of this packer. It must be turned in to a Homecoming representative in the Homecoming office by August 26<sup>th</sup> at 5PM.

## Banner Guidelines:

*Banners will be judged when displayed in the GC Atrium on Monday, September 26, 2011*

***\*The focus of your banner should go along with your team's name and overall Homecoming theme.\****

1. All banners must be no larger than 4ft x 6ft. The banner must not be more than 3 inches in depth. The banner can be vertical or horizontal and must have **holes** on the top of the banner in order for the banner to be hung in the Atrium.
2. All banner **designs** must be submitted by **5pm** on September 12, 2011 to GC 2214.
3. The physical banner is due by **5pm** on September 23, 2011 to GC 2214
4. Banners will be judged based on the use of the Homecoming theme, originality, creativity, and school spirit.
5. All banners must have the team name placed on it.
6. Banners deemed, by the judges and/or the Homecoming Council, as racist, sexist, slanderous, offensive, vulgar, or etc. will be **disqualified**.
7. Banners will not be returned to the teams unless specifically requested.
8. The use of Roary, FIU logos and non-FIU trademarked logos is prohibited.
9. During the day of the parade (October 1<sup>st</sup>), a maximum of 5 team members may walk in the parade with their banner, if the team is not participating in the walking.

## T-Shirt Guidelines:

1. All teams must include Homecoming's overall theme in a T-Shirt design along with their Team Name.
2. A color copy of the team's t-shirt designs must be turned in by 5pm on **September 12, 2011** to GC 2214..
3. Any shirts deemed inappropriate are allowed one redesign before being disqualified from competition.
4. The actual t-shirt must be turned in by 5pm on **September 23, 2011** to GC 2214.
5. Participating Teams are encouraged to wear their T-Shirt designs the Homecoming Parade on October 1<sup>st</sup> .
6. Participating Teams are **NOT** allowed to seek Campus Life employees or professional publications in their designs
- 7. Any differences in T-shirt with copy of design will result in disqualification.**
8. The use of Roary, FIU logos and non-FIU trademarked logos is prohibited.

## Lip Sync/Talent Show:

*A Lip Sync performance is described as moving the lips silently in synchronization with a pre-recorded soundtrack. This performance also includes a choreographed dance to match the Lip Sync.*

**\*Lip Sync performances are reserved for teams using a minimum of 6 performers and a maximum of 20 performers. Talent Show performances are allowed a maximum of 10 performers from a team.\***

### LIP SYNC Rules:

1. Each team is allowed 6-20 performers. The names and panther ID's of the participants must be turned in with the registration form on September 12, 2011 by 5pm to GC 2214. If a participant is involved with multiple organizations, they must choose 1 to perform with.
2. The last day to change the names of the performers is **September 12, 2011** by 5pm to GC 2214. All changes must be written and submitted to GC 2214. There will no name changing allowed after the due date.
3. Each Team will have EXACTLY 7 minutes, including **set-up** and **breakdown**. A lip sync performer must cue the DJ when to start the music. Time ends when all performers and any carried on props are completely off stage. 5 points per second deduction will occur after the 7 minutes period is over.
4. There is no limit on the number of songs a team may perform.
5. Songs used in the performance must be edited for content and lyrics. An edited version of the music being used for competition must be turned in for review by 5pm on September 12, 2011 to GC 2214. The music must be submitted in both **CD format** and an **mp3** format. The mp3 format needs to be sent by email to the Lip Sync Chair, AD of Administration and the Overall Director.
6. Once a team has turned in the first original draft, songs and format can **NO** longer be changed **UNLESS** deemed inappropriate by the Lip Sync Chair, AD of Administration, and Overall Director.
7. If a team is asked to change any music, it must be done by **September 16<sup>th</sup>** and turned in by 5pm to GC 2214. Once the music has been approved it can no longer be changed.
8. Team lip sync performers must all check in together **7pm** on **Friday September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2011**. Performers are responsible for presenting a valid Panther ID at check in. The only excuse for a late check in is class, work, or emergency.
9. Performance order will be decided by random drawing at the Homecoming Pep Rally on **Monday, September 26<sup>th</sup>, 2011** between 12pm-2pm. Team representatives **MUST** be present in order to receive additional information regarding HC events.

10. All participants must be dressed appropriately or the team will be **disqualified**. Questions about appropriateness may be directed towards the Lip Sync Chair, the Rules & Regulations Chair, and/or the Overall Director at least 48 hours prior to Lip Sync.

11. Any performances deemed inappropriate by the judges may cause the team to be **disqualified**. Other clubs/organizations or teams may not be negatively portrayed on stage.

12. Performers must remain backstage in the designated practice area while waiting to perform. However, three registered team representatives are allowed backstage **ONLY** with proper identification.

13. While teams are performing, performers may only be on stage or on the side waiting. Performers **CANNOT** stand in front of the stage or run through the audience.

14. Any liquid, glitter, and/or powder-like material will not be allowed because of potential safety hazards.

15. The stage must be left in the same condition as it was found. During the performance, teams may use props but all props must be taken off the stage at the end of the performance. Props may **NOT** be thrown from the stage during or after the performance. Props **CANNOT** be stored in the vicinity of Blue/ Gold Garage before or after the performance.

**16. Any Props not removed from the premises an hour after the show will receive a 20 points deduction.**

17. The use of alcohol/drugs by participants/ team members before or during the competition will result in the **disqualification** of that team.

18. Lip Sync will be judged in the following categories including creativity, incorporation of FIU spirit and Homecoming Theme, choreography, costumes, “Lipsyncing”, and overall performance.

19. All winners will be announced at Halftime during the Homecoming Game on Saturday October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011

20. The Lip Sync team form, which can be found on page 19 of this packet, needs to be turned in by 5pm on September 12<sup>th</sup> to GC 2214

21. The Lip Sync/Talent Show Chair, Rules & Regulations Chair, along with the AD of Administration are the **ONLY** persons allowed to make executive decisions in regards to any special changes, directions, rules, timing, etc. on the day of Lip Sync.

## **TALENT SHOW Rules:**

**ALL of Lip Sync rules apply to Talent Show rules with a few exceptions:**

1. For any one talent a minimum of one person can perform and a maximum of 10 people can perform.
2. Talent show performance consists of any talent act other than Lip Syncing (ex: Drum Line, Interpretive dance, any musical instrument.)
2. Equipment required must be brought by the participating teams. Homecoming Council will provide a microphone, which will be connected to a sound system. Only Music in CD/mp3 format will be played.
3. Each team or participant will only have **6 minutes** total on stage including **set-up** and **breakdown** of all props.
4. Overall talent show winner will be announced at the Homecoming Game.
5. The Talent Show team form, which can be found on page 19 of this packet, needs to be turned in by 5pm on September 12, 2011 to GC 2214.

6. The Lip Sync/Talent Show Chair, Rules & Regulations Chair, along with the AD of Administration are the **ONLY** person to make executive decisions in regards to any special changes, directions, rules, timing, etc. on the day of Lip Sync.

## **Float Guidelines:**

***\*\* Please be aware that the rules for the Parade have changed this year. Please read through everything carefully \*\****

*Check-In: Midnight on October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011 in RDB Loop*

*Check -In: 10am on October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011 in RDB Loop*

*Floats will be judged before the parade begins.*

1. Teams participating in the float competition will need to indicate so on the form turned in on August 26<sup>th</sup>.
2. Homecoming council will provide both a “box” of supply materials for each team as well as theme specific items which must be used on the float. Other materials may be used by teams in the building of their float.
3. Teams are prohibited from bringing any **assembled** objects that will be used in the building of the float either at the Midnight check in or at the 10 am check in on October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011.
4. Teams are encouraged to bring as much supplies and manpower as they see fit.

5. Materials will be distributed immediately following lip sync and building of the float must take place in the Ryder Business Loop (RDB). Float building is designed as a “sprint competition” in which teams have a limited amount of time to use their creativity and resources to create a float.
6. Building of the float will be limited to 12am-5am October 1<sup>st</sup>. Teams may return to place any last minute touches between 10am – 12pm on October 1<sup>st</sup>.
7. Floats should be ready to be judged by 1pm SHARP.
8. Nothing may be thrown from any float.
9. Float dimensions must NOT exceed 8ft wide x 45ft long x 15ft high. The height will be measured from the ground to the highest point on the float. The width will be measured from the two most outermost points on the float. **The length will be measured from the front of the vehicle to the end of the float. This DOES include the vehicle towing the float.** Floats exceeding dimensions **will be deducted 10pts**.
10. Floats must be towed by a motor vehicle.
11. The Homecoming representatives of each team must be with the float at **all times** while in the staging area and for the extent of the parade route.
12. Each tow vehicle must contain a working portable 5 lb fire extinguisher with the rating 2A, 10B: C and be readily available to the operator. The fire extinguisher will be checked during check-in. If there is no fire extinguisher, the float will be **deducted 15pts**
13. If used, generators must be placed on the tow vehicle and must be capable of providing the needed electrical service. Each generator must contain a minimum of two electrical outlets.
14. Before the floats leave the construction lot to go into the parade line-up, each teams specific area must be cleaned. This includes but is not limited to paint spots left on the grass. All materials must be thrown away in dumpsters, the area must be inspected, and each team must receive the approval to line-up from a Homecoming Council Member.
15. Any floats deemed unsafe or inappropriate by the Homecoming Parade Chair, AD of Administration or FIU Police will be removed from the parade and disqualified from the Float competition.
16. The maximum amount of people allowed on the float is 10, excluding a driver and 1 passenger.
17. The driver, passenger, and all team members on the float must be current FIU students and on the roster with valid Panther ID’s.

18. **ALL** members participating on the float **MUST** have turned in signed waivers by September 12, 2011 by 5pm in GC 2214. During the course of the parade, no one may get on and off the float, including the driver and the passenger.

19. Items prohibited on the float include but are not limited to: fire, fireworks, live animals, and smoke machines.

20. Parade line up will be determined by a random drawing during the Homecoming Pep Rally on Monday, September 26<sup>th</sup>, 2011 in the GC Pit.

### **Spirit Car Guidelines:**

*Spirit Cars will be judged before the parade begins.  
 Check-In: Midnight on October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011 in RDB Loop  
 Check –In: 10am on October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011 in RDB Loop  
 Spirit Cars will be judged before the parade begins.*

***\*The focus of your spirit car should go along with your team’s name\****

1. Spirit Cars serve the purpose for teams who want to participate in the Homecoming parade but without building a float.

2. Teams doing a Spirit Car will be given only theme specific items to work with that must be incorporated on their car. Other materials may be incorporated in the designing of the spirit car.

3. Teams are prohibited from bringing any **assembled** objects that will be used in the assembly of their spirit cars either at the Midnight check in or at the 10 am check in on October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011.

4. Teams are encouraged to bring as much supplies and manpower as they see fit.

5. Materials will be distributed immediately following lip sync and assembly of Spirit cars must take place in the Ryder Business Loop. Spirit car assembly is designed as a “sprint competition” in which teams have a limited amount of time to use their creativity and resources to create a Spirit Car.

6. Assembly of Spirit Cars will be limited to 12am-5pm September 30<sup>th</sup> / October 1<sup>st</sup>. Teams may return to place any last minute touches between 10am – 12pm on October 1<sup>st</sup>.

7. Nothing may be thrown by any Spirit Car passengers.

8. Each Spirit Car cannot have more passengers than available seatbelts. A maximum of 3 people may ride on the bed of trucks, and must stay seated at all times. Failure to comply will result in a 15 points deduction.

9. There may **NOT** be a trailer being towed by the Spirit Car.

10. Any Spirit Car deemed unsafe or inappropriate by the Homecoming Special Events Chair, E-Board, or FIU Police will be removed from the parade and disqualified from the Spirit Car competition.

2. If a team wants to participate in the walking brigade they are required to turn in the form on August 26<sup>th</sup> at 5pm in GC 2214
3. The maximum number of participants in a teams walking brigade is limited to 25 members.
4. Objects may be tossed into the crowd by any brigade members including but not limited to candy with prior consent of the Homecoming Council.
5. Participants must have filled out a waiver to be turned in by September 29th.
6. Once the parade has begun, no members may leave, switch, or join the brigade.
7. Any inappropriate behavior during the Parade will be removed from the parade and disqualified from the Brigade by the Homecoming Parade Chair and E-board.
8. All participants must follow the FIU Student Code of Conduct.
